FOOTBALL SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT

Our Club's philosophy is that every child that has the desire to play youth football should be given the opportunity regardless of financial need. Families in need of player scholarships are required to complete the "Scholarship" section of our online registration. The Board of Directors will review each scholarship application and decide to approve or deny based on financial need and past Club experience. Head Coaches provide feedback on each returning player and their interactions with the player's parents/guardians.

Scholarship Player/Parent Expectations

Players and parents/guardians granted scholarships by the Club are required to commit to our program and achieve the following <u>minimum</u> requirements:

- Submit all required paperwork by deadlines
- Attend all required Parent/Player meetings
- Attend official Equipment Check-out and Weigh-in session
- Player must attend 90% of practices and games
- Arrive <u>on time</u> to practices and games. Also must be on time to pick child up from practices and games.
- Player will demonstrate a desire to learn the game, work hard, and be a good team member
- Parent/guardian should help with Club volunteer duties whenever available
- Attend official Equipment Return session with ALL equipment cleaned and dry

Scholarship players who do not comply with the above requirements may be removed from the Club and/or <u>will not</u> be granted scholarships in subsequent seasons.
